
Parkrose Secondary Vision

Our Shared Assumptions

- The educational system is inequitable by design.
 - Oppressive systems and practices negatively impact students' learning.
 - We can't expect change at macro levels unless we disrupt our practices at micro levels.
 - Oppressive practices in future settings (e.g., college and career) do not justify oppressive practices in our current setting.
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Staff Support

Professional Development to support all staff

- Building relational capacity on our secondary team
- Increase empathy and understanding amongst staff
 - Vicarious trauma
 - Compassion fatigue
 - Recognizing our own trauma response
- Identify building level supports

Student Support

Empathy Day

- Pause instruction
- Focus on social/emotional skills
- Build empathy skills with our students

6th Grade Empathy Day


Reasons Needed:

- Over 60% of our discipline referrals are from 6th graders
- Parent, Students and Teachers have reported over 50 incidents of harassment via chats and social media.
- The top referrals are fighting, bullying/harassment

What we noticed may have contributed to the spike in 6th grade referrals?

- Missed being in school 3rd, 4th and portion of 5th grade
- Social Media/Technology Influence
- Peer Pressure
- Past Trauma

Empathy Day

A day dedicated to social emotional learning centered around Empathy.

- **6th Grade Assembly**
- **Four Teacher-led Lessons**
 - **Empathy Map**
 - Empathy maps are a collaborative tool used to build a holistic understanding of what a certain person (or "user") thinks, feels, sees etc.
 - **Identity Circle**
 - This is a deeper get-to-know-you game, during which you will have an opportunity to discuss with many friends the values that make up your identity and how you prioritize them in your life.
 - **Dealing with Digital Drama**
 - Lesson designed to help students responsibly deal with online bullying/harassment
 - **Rock'n Values**
 - Students create a presentation describing how you can be the change and be an upstander and positive support for students at PMS.
- **Admin-Led "Step to the Line" Activity**
 - Students are be able to:
 - To increase the understanding of how behaviors and attitudes impact others.
 - To highlight the similarities between students.
 - To recognize some of the factors which may influence feeling safe at school.
 - To encourage student-led changes in school culture.
