SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of the cost to establish new fiber infrastructure at Braswell High School and fiber infrastructure replacement at three locations: US 377 crossing at Acme Street, Hickory Creek at Old Alton Road, and on Naylor Road.

BOARD GOAL:

VI. Growth, Change and Fiscal Responsibility...demonstrate effective and efficient management of district resources.

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

The district is currently in contract with Henkels & McCoy for fiber engineering services. This gives the District the security of allowing Henkels & McCoy to protect and service our fiber optic network. This contract will expire June 7, 2016.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Henkels & McCoy has assisted with fiber engineering services for the district for several years.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

Denton ISD is responsible for the costs associated with all locations. However, Denton County will reimburse the District a portion of the cost. The final cost to the District will be \$172,033.71. The project at Braswell High School will be funded from the 2013 Bonds. The remaining projects will be funded from contingency in the 2007 Bonds.
