Issue Summary:

To support the Iñupiaq Language Classroom curriculum, supplement general education classrooms, and for families in the North Slope Borough School District, the District is purchasing Iñupiaq Language curricular materials and resources in the form of card games from Native Teaching Aids.

Background:

As part of the NSBSD's commitment to graduating bilingual students, cultural preservation, and engaging language instruction, the Iñupiaq Education Department has developed and aligned instructional materials with the Iñupiaq Language Program Scope & Sequence. The purchase includes culturally relevant card games designed to reinforce language skills in an interactive and accessible format. These resources offer hands-on opportunities for vocabulary acquisition, sentence formation, and conversational practice, tailored to different proficiency levels and dialects.

The materials will be integrated into all Iñupiaq Language classrooms across the district and made available to general education teachers to incorporate Iñupiaq language into their instruction. In addition, two sets will be distributed to each household within the North Slope Borough School District, strengthening family engagement and encouraging language use at home. This initiative supports multiple strategic goals, including working towards graduating bilingual students, student achievement, community involvement, and the development of culturally responsive classrooms.
