SUBJECT: **DISCUSSION OF AND REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF APPLICATION FOR OPTIONAL FLEXIBLE SCHOOL DAY PROGRAM (OFSDP)**

DATE: September 24, 2019

The High School Principals, Executive Directors, Teen Pregnancy Coordinator, and the Lead Social Worker of the Community Outreach Center have worked together to complete the Optional Flexible School Day Program application. The goal of the Optional Flexible School Day Program is to allow students an opportunity to have flexible hours in order to be successful and receive a high school diploma by offering courses needed for graduation while the district receives funding for students in attendance. The program has two main objectives. The first objective is to allow a student who has dropped out of school or is in danger of dropping out of school an option other than the regular classroom setting or school day. The second objective is to enable a student the opportunity to recover credits lost due to lack of attendance. The program will go into effect 30 days after the application is submitted.

There will be no cost for ECISD.
