Fire Watch

The State Fire Marshal's Office requires a fire-watch to be initiated when a facility's fire protection system(s) is/are not operational or other reasons determined by the State Fire Marshal. (Fire-watch may not be substituted for a kitchen hood and duct suppression system).

The **SOLE DUTY** of the fire-watch personnel shall be to serve as an on-site fire-watch. The fire-watch consists of a person dedicated to perform the fire-watch and capable of initiating the emergency plan. A complete walk-through of the facility shall be performed hourly.

The fire watch will occur 24 hours a day and will continue until the system(s) is operational, **not to exceed ten (10) days,** unless a written extension is granted by the State Fire Marshal.
