REGULATION

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DRUG, ALCOHOL, AND TOBACCO/ NICOTINE-FREE SCHOOLS

<u>All entrances to buildings and athletic facilities will be posted with a notice that the use, possession, or distribution of commercial tobacco and nicotine product(s), electronic delivery device(s), alcoholic beverage(s), mood-altering substance(s), and illicit drug(s) are prohibited.</u>

This prohibition applies to all school property and all off-campus, school-sponsored events as those terms are defined in the New Mexico Administrative Code 6.12.4. Announcements will be made at school activities and events.

<u>Members of the public using or possessing prohibited products on school premises</u> and failing to respond to a verbal warning shall be requested to leave the premises by school supervisory personnel in accord with laws on trespass. Law enforcement may be notified if deemed necessary.
