PLAN FOR TRANSITION TO ON-CAMPUS INSTRUCTION

United Independent School District will offer parents options of either on-campus instruction (Transition Plan) beginning September 21, 2020, or the option to continue remote/virtual learning at home.

United ISD will begin providing on-campus instruction in a phase-in manner beginning September 21, 2020 for those who select this option. Please note that the District will continue to offer remote/virtual learning for students whose parents want them to continue receiving instruction at home.

Based on previous survey information, the District expects approximately 20% of its 42,000 students to take part in on-campus instruction. The expected percentage of students returning allows for social distancing, enhanced monitoring of implementation of health protocols, and minimal person-to-person contact. Any school that has more than 50% of the students returning for on-campus instruction will be considered for implementation of a hybrid attendance schedule. In this case, students will attend school on campus two or three days a week and the remaining days of the week students will participate in remote/virtual learning from home. Parents will be notified by school of the option if the hybrid schedule is to be implemented.

The District's transition plan will allow for students to return in small numbers. This allows each campus the opportunity to improve on their safety/health protocols in order to enhance them.

United ISD will continue to monitor the local health trends/conditions on a regular basis to base decisions.

The District will make all attempts to notify families at least 5 days prior for when their child may return for on-campus instruction.

PLAN FOR TRANSITION TO ON-CAMPUS INSTRUCTION

LEARNING MODELS:

ON-CAMPUS (FACE-TO-FACE) LEARNING

HOW IT WORKS: Learning that happens in a traditional classroom setting five days a week with a teacher (not necessarily your child's classroom teacher) and students on campus. In some instances, your child may be receiving instruction through a remote platform while physically sitting in a class with an assigned grade level/content area teacher. All safety guidelines will be implemented. Any school that has more than 50% of the students returning for on-campus instruction will be considered for the implementation of a hybrid attendance schedule. In this case, students will attend school on campus two or three days a week and the remaining days of the week students will participate in remote/virtual learning from home. Parents will be notified by the school of the option if the hybrid schedule is to be implemented.

Parents selecting this option may return to the remote learning model through the end of a grading cycle (six or nine weeks). At that time, parents can opt for the remote learning model. Parents must notify their child's school if they want to change options for the start of the next grading cycle. Parents may continue to participate in the on-campus learning model until otherwise notified by the District. Please note that if there are multiple confirmed cases of COVID-19, the school may be required to shut down for an extended period of time. If this occurs, your child will transition to remote/virtual learning at home.

REMOTE/VIRTUAL LEARNING AT HOME

HOW IT WORKS: This model allows students to receive their instruction at home through an asynchronous remote learning model that has been approved by the Texas Education Agency.

Parents selecting this option must remain with remote/virtual learning model through the end of a grading cycle (six or nine weeks). At that time, parents can opt for the on-campus (face-to-face) learning model. Parents must notify their child's school if they want to change options for the start of the next grading cycle. Parents may continue to participate in the remote learning model until otherwise notified by the District.
