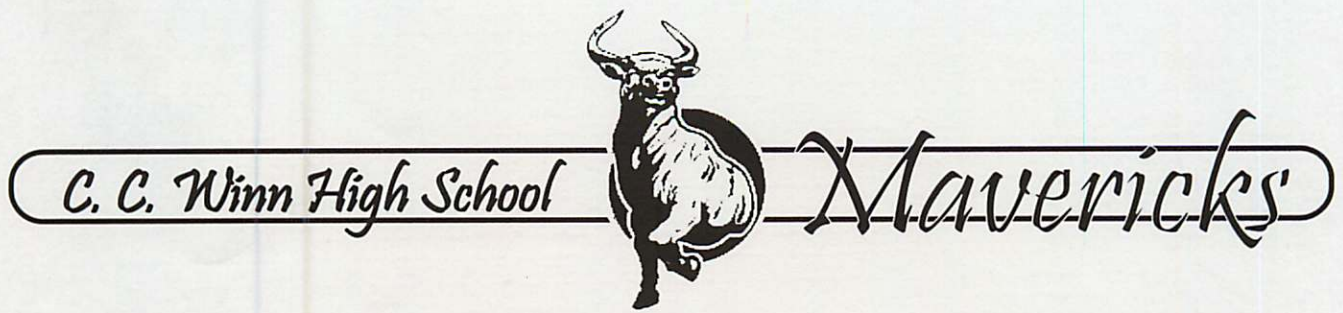

The District 29-AAAAA Cross-Examination (CX) Debate Tournament was held this past Friday night and Saturday morning at Alexander High School in Laredo Texas. Twelve teams vied to decide the top two debate teams that will represent our district at the state CX-Debate meet. Representing C. C. Winn was the senior team of Cinthia Alvarado/Salvador Villagomez and the sophomore team of Adrian Gonzalez/Issac Turrubiate. The three rounds of preliminary CX-Debate started at 5 pm on Friday and concluded at midnight with the announcement of four teams advancing to Semi-finals. The team of Alvarado/Villagomez advanced along with two teams from Alexander High School and one team from United South High School. In the Semi-final round starting at 9 am Saturday, the fourth seeded team of Alvarado/Villagomez advanced to the final round and state competition by defeating the first seeded team from Alexander High School of Ramos/Gonzalez in a two-one split decision that went the full allotted time of 80 minutes. In the final round, Alvarado/Villagomez faced the winner of the other Semi-final round, the Alexander High team of Cervantes/Brown. In another 2-1 split-decision that also went the full time, Alvarado/Villagomez defeated the Alexander team and received the first place medals. Alvarado/Villagomez’s first place standing also earned the Second Place Debate Team plaque for C. C. Winn, with Alexander taking the first place team plaque for their second and third place teams. The top two teams now advance to the state CX Debate Tournament that will be held at the University of Texas at Austin March 14-15.
