- The SpEd Department is continuing to correct Evaluation Reports and Individual Education Plans that are not aligned to each other. To date we have corrected 12 student IEP's that did not align with their Evaluation Reports, and have 4 more that have been discovered as we complete the yearly IEP cycle. The goal is, by the end of the year identify all misalignments and have them scheduled for reassessment either this year, or early next fall.

productive meetings going through documentation of previous classes, IEP's,
progress reports and other available data to make plans for individual students

will need to have acquired 20.5 credits through the IEP goal process. These
credits are identified when the IEP's of these students are progress monitored
with fidelity, (a minimum of twice a quarter) to ensure that the goal was
successfully reached and a credit can be given. A credit for a goal cannot be
given if there is no evidence to support that the goal was reached.
