Intelligent Irrigation Installation Change Order #1

SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of a change order for repairs needed to the existing irrigation system at several campus and facility locations.

BOARD GOAL:

VI. Growth, Change & Fiscal Responsibility...demonstrate effective and efficient management of District resources.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

RFP# 170413 for Intelligent Irrigation Installation was submitted for approval on April 25, 2017. The project was awarded to TD Industries, Inc. in the amount of \$964,119.00. Converting several campus and district facility locations to an Intelligent Irrigation System was included in the 2013 bond as an energy conservation project. The system is operational at several of the newer campus locations.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

It was discovered during installation that many of the existing systems needed repair. These repairs need to be completed before the new system can be fully installed and tested.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The cost of the repairs to the systems contained in change order #1 is \$122,817.00. The General Fund Major Maintenance budget will be utilized to fund this project.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

Passage will allow repairs to be made to complete the project.

SUPERINTENDENT'S RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that change order #1 from TD Industries, Inc. in the amount of \$122,817.00 be accepted.
