Draft Goals

- Secure funding for/build new high school or new learning facility (i.e. 1925 school building on hill) or renovate existing high school
- Facilities Upgrades at high school (cosmetic, maintenance, paint, tile)—shorter term goals
- Increased academic outcomes (growth) as measured on local (MAPS), state (PEAKS), and national (ACT/PSAT/SAT) assessments
- Implementation of an Early Warning System for at-risk students in order to provide additional support (reduce drop-out potential/increase graduation rate)
- Ongoing development of course opportunities that directly tie to application of knowledge and life skills ("how to" courses)
- Support/educate the whole student (social emotional learning). (Consider developing as a principle statement?).
