Please state your proposal briefly and clearly. What do you want the board to know, discuss, or decide?

I am proposing establishing some formal guidelines for approving or non-approving volunteers, and particularly volunteer coaches and overnight chaperones. The attachments are in use at Eagle Point and are communicated to administrative staff as a guide when community volunteers approach them and disclose their criminal history. I would suggest adding "person" to the wording instead of just "children," as it is important that the adults we deem as responsible to be with our students should also be good role models.

Provide history/background information on your proposal.

Currently, the District denies volunteers for any crime against a person. While that is a fairly straight line to evaluate applications against, it does not allow for any evaluation of extenuating circumstances, or time since the offense occurred. We do also deny for the other items on the list; however there is no time limit.
