REVISED POLICY - VOL. 30, NO. 2

5520 - DISORDERLY CONDUCT

The Board-recognizes the right of each student to attend school for the purpose of receiving an education. **Students involved in <u>t</u>** he disruption of the educational program of the schools by disorder or any other purposeful activity <u>may be subject to</u> <u>disciplinary consequences, including, but not limited to, suspension and expulsion</u>.

[X] For purposes of this policy, disorder shall be any deliberate activity by an individual or a group, whether peaceful or violent, which is reasonably likely to disrupt the normal operation of the school.

The Board, having the responsibility for providing an educational program for the students of this District, shall have the authority to preserve order for the proper functioning of **its that** program.

Students shall not be disturbed in the exercise of their constitutionally guaranteed rights to assemble peaceably and to express ideas and opinions, privately or publicly, provided that such exercise does not infringe on the rights of others and does not interfere with the operation of the schools.
