1. We have individual chairs that students sit on while they are in the cafeteria. Students must hold tray while pulling out the chair to sit at times causing their tray to spill.
2. When student lunch time is over, some students do not put in their chairs and other students have fallen because not all of the students remember to tuck the chair under the table. This causes a safety issue for our students.
3. The attached stools also give students more room to walk in between tables.

## LRC Capital Outlay Request and Summary

## Technology Request

The Learning Resource Center is requesting the funds to purchase 25 additional Nova Net licenses at a cost of $\$ 1,000.00$ per license, thereby, totaling $\$ 25,000.00$. I realize that this is an exorbitant amount of money but, in the event that this request is more than allowed for any single request we would be grateful to receive any amount that the board deems fair / appropriate.

## Rationale for Request

The Nova Net Lab is the computer program that our campus uses to assist students to remediate and accelerate a total of 28 content / curricular areas. Through the use of this program we are able to provide services to approximately 200-300 (total for the year) A.C. Jones students during the Fall, Spring and Summer Sessions. The Nova Net Program provides all of the foundational academic skills to the students that attend the LRC campus during the day. We presently have 25 licenses for our campus and could use more to accommodate the number of students that attend our campus both during the day and for the after-school and summer programs.

## Madderra's Capital Outlay Justification

 October 30, 20061. A laser scanner for our campus is needed to make our own tests with the testing materials purchased from Scantron.
2. Nine Elmos would replace the old overhead projectors in our classrooms (two per grade level and one for the library). The Elmos would provide a new level of visual communication for our students.
3. Two new desktop computers would replace some of the computers that are not working properly in the technology lab. This lab is where the students practice the technology TEKS with the state adopted software curriculum, Easy Tech.
4. Chairs are needed for the students to use in the classrooms and for guest seating when special events are held in the gym. Some of our students' plastic chairs are held together with duct tape. The chairs we use for programs are old and were inherited from Central Cafeteria when it was remodeled in the early nineties.
5. Two new Smart Boards would enhance our technology program. Currently we have one that is utilized by the Fine Arts teacher. One would be placed in a second grade classroom and the other in a fourth grade classroom. These teachers are current with their tech skills.
