Please accept this letter as notification that I wish to resign from my position as Site Supervisor within BPS Food Services, with effective from the date above.

It is with a heavy heart that I leave the position which I have assumed for the past nine months, but due to on-going health issues of continuous headaches/migraines (medical doctors are still attempting to accurately diagnose), I find it is no longer possible to continue my duties with the school district.
