Campus Improvement Plan Presentation

<u>Purpose of Report</u>: Principals will report the development of the Campus Improvement Plans (CIPs) as developed by principals with the assistance of Campus Leadership Teams. Common themes amongst vertical zones will be addressed. Connections will be made to the work of the Educational Improvement Council (EIC) and the district mission statement.

Objectives: In an effort to demonstrate effective planning, principals will provide the board with the common themes identified in each vertical zone and connections of individual CIPs to the mission of the district and to the work of the EIC. Operational Impact: The campus Wildly Important Goals (WIGs) drive the planning process. Lead activities guide the campuses in accomplishing its WIGs. Evidence of implementation and evidence of impact provide clarity on how lead activities are achieved. By focusing on a few, specific WIGs, research indicates campuses are more likely to accomplish the goals.

<u>**Results:**</u> Campuses will continue to monitor progress on the new CIP template, which was redesigned in 2013-14 to reflect measurable progress in multiple points in the school year.
