





### Kajeet SmartBus


We have 5 Cradelpoint IBR-900 Verizon hotspots installed on three route buses and two trip buses. Over the past few months we have been tweaking the daily data allowance trying to find the most efficient way to manage our data allotment. We are also working with Kajeet to determine how data is being reported used while the busses are off. We are exploring options to manage the data allotment based on scheduled events. I have included screenshots from our dashboard for the month of March.








#### **Top 20 Denied Domains** Based On 03/01/2018 - 03/31/2018





## **T-Mobile Hotspots**

The 25 mobile hotspots have been configured and prepared for deployment. We are currently waiting on our T-Mobile Dashboard to be populated with our devices so that we can monitor data usage to better understand the device status prior to rechecking the hotspot. The setup process can take two billing cycles. I reached out to Allen today, our account manager, and he assures me they are almost finished with it. The devices will be checked out in the library using Alexandria software. A request form was sent out to all 7th-12th grade students using Google Classroom. We had a total of 28 respondents. 11 of the respondents indicated they had no access to internet at home. Mr. Birchfield and the SHS Metal Jacket Robotics team took several of the hotspots with them to their competition in March. Mr. Birchfield reported that the preloaded configuration profiles on the student iPads allowed them to connect to the Sville Mobile secure network without issue.
