SB 13 Requirements

- Districts must post a proposed book purchase list online for 30 days for comment and review.
 - Allows parents to voice any concerns and participate in the selection process.
 - EFB (Local) established a process if parents want the librarians to reconsider a resource on the list.
- SB13 requires school boards to approve library purchase lists in a public Board meeting before they can be procured.



Parental Access to Library Catalog

Districts must have a mechanism for parents to review and restrict access by their children to specified library materials.

Parents can access the Library Catalog using the Follet Destiny Link on the CHISD Library Homepage.



Library Resource vs. Instructional Resource

This policy applies to Library Resources **ONLY**

- **Library Resource:** voluntary student access
- **Instructional Resource:** planned extension of classroom lesson



Next Steps

- Librarians submit their list of proposed NEW materials to the Instructional Technology Coordinator.
- The Board receives the list of proposed materials to be approved.
- After lists have been posted for 30 days, the list is taken to the Board for approval.
- The librarians can purchase books on the list as funds become available.
