

Nursing Update

Southwest Texas College

Texas Senate Bill 1429

- Enacted and effective September 1, 2023.
 - It prohibits nursing programs in Texas from using vendor-created standardized exams as graduation requirements or as a basis to deny students the affidavit of graduation, a document required by the Texas Board of Nursing (BON) to register for the NCLEX.
- Programs can still use standardized exams for non-high-stakes purposes, such as:
 - Familiarizing students with computerized testing
 - Assessing strengths/weaknesses for remediation
 - Admissions screening, where appropriate
 - Evaluating curriculum effectiveness
- Limitations on weight: Any standardized exam prepared by a private entity's score may account for no more than 10% of a course grade, and schools may not require students to enroll in remediation through the test provider.
- Enforcement: Non-compliance may result in disciplinary actions or even loss of program approval by the BON.

- The Texas Board of Nursing (BON) mandates that all nursing schools have an 80% pass rate per program on the students' first attempt.
- Measures Taken:
 - Comprehensive self-report written following 2024 results
 - Saturday tutoring sessions
 - Simulation lab remediation to enhance skills
 - ATI remediation (Greenlighting) Encouraged
 - Growth plans for students
 - Eight-week nursing home clinicals before hospital clinicals (recommended by BON)



2025-2026

- Fully staffed at all sites
 - New ADN and LVN faculty hired in Eagle Pass
 - New ADN faculty in Uvalde.
- Program expansion
 - Exploring the addition of an LVN night cohort.



TRUE Pathways Grant

- \$155,000
- Purpose: to fund the development of a nursing pathway from dual credit through a master's program.
 - Students will be able to complete their nursing pre-requisite courses in high school (15 hours of college credit) and apply to the nursing program as seniors.
 - Students will earn an LVN degree and progress through the ADN pathway (SWTX).
 - Students will be able to complete a BSN and an MSN completely online without having to leave home.
