Re:	i-Ready ELA Assessment Suite for Grades K-8

Recommendation:

That the Board of Trustees approve the purchase of the iReady ELA Assessment Suite for grades K-8 for 5 years, at \$217,336 from the General Fund annually.

Background Information:

The iReady ELA Assessment Suite was designed using both criterion- and normative-based measures, providing teachers with clear, actionable data that can be filtered down to the level of NV Academic Content Standards. This tool allows educators to adjust their Tier 1 instruction, supporting all learners and offering progress monitoring at the classroom, school, and district levels. It also allows teachers to use an additional data point to identify students who are placed on a Reading Acceleration Plan (RAP) under the Nevada Read by Grade Three Act.

iReady's individualized pathways will help students address their next instructional steps through adaptive and engaging lessons aligned with academic content standards. Teachers also have access to a library of personalized instructional lessons that correlate with Tier 1 content, which can be assigned to the whole class or specific student groups.

Additionally, while the digital platform helps accelerate student learning, the Teacher Toolbox offers K-8 supplemental materials to support spiraling learning targets throughout the year. These lessons are available for previewing or review later in the year. Small group resources and teacher-led centers will also be accessible.
