After the incident of the Florida shooting Mr. Montes decided to look into more information and came across ALICE and attended a conference. Mr. Montes discussed a blueprint (how to implement situations) of the program. Mr. Montes stated that each school is designed differently meaning different protocols. The most difficult thing about this program is how to implement the logistics. Mr. Montes enlightened what ALICE stands for: A= Alert: (CCWH is working on how to announce a lockdown ex: a situation is happening and if a teacher is in the hall and becomes aware, what should take place) L= Lockdown (How to secure doors, educate staff how to barricade their door(s)). I= Inform (how to communicate. Alert & Inform go hand in hand) C= Counter (how to respond once intruder is in the building/classrooms... Last resort by throwing chairs, desks, books, etc., anything to distract intruder from shooting) E= Evacuation (where each student will be for safety when evacuating building and informing law enforcement where the students have been secured.)
