School Improvement

- 5 Essentials Update - the HS students are at 93% completion; teachers 78% and parents 18%. We need a couple more parents to complete this so we can get the parent feedback report next year. We have met all of the other state targets.
- We have been awarded Bronze Honors from ISAC for our Financial Aid Application Completion for the Class of 2022. In order to receive this honor our school achieved a completion rate of 70%. This is ONLY for those students who completed a FAFSA application NOT the Opt-Outs. In order for us to receive the Silver Honors our school would need to achieve a completion rate of 75% or higher. we are currently at 73% completion for the class of 2023 and have 10 Seniors who still need to complete their FAFSA or Opt-out form.
