# Senior Survey 2020-2021

Typically, senior students meet with their counselor to complete the senior survey. Due to the hybrid learning environment in the spring of 2021, the survey was administered virtually through a Google Form. When we are in person we are able to ensure that we have all students complete the survey. Every effort was made to get students to complete the survey while hybrid, but we did not have 100% participation in completing the survey or updating their college admissions data in Cialfo. Though 315 seniors did complete the survey, a majority did not update their admissions data in Cialfo. This means that the acceptance data for the class of 2021 is incomplete.

This survey is designed to provide information on our students' plans upon graduation. It also provides some statistics in relation to their post-secondary planning. 76% of students who responded to the survey plan to pursue a post-secondary education next year on a full or part-time basis.

Statistics in the Senior Profile are based on self-reported information from students in a survey taken May through June of 2021 as well as self reported admissions information on Cialfo.

FAFSA statistics are provided from a partnership with the Illinois Student Assistance Commission.


**315** graduating seniors submitted a survey about their plans following graduation.

# **Career Information**

• 313 students shared which Fenton Career Pathway they are pursuing after graduation. The results are shown below:



• 312 students shared their specific career goals which resulted in over 200 different career choices.

### **College Admissions Information**

- A total of 264 graduates sent out 1229 applications for admission to 276 colleges.
- 62 different post secondary institutions will be attended by the class of 2021.
- Students are majoring in 102 different programs. The most common majors were:
  - 1. Undecided (99)
  - 2. Business (16)
  - 3. Nursing (13)
  - 4. Psychology (12)
  - 5. Engineering (10)
- 66% of students who responded to the survey are first-generation college students.

- For those attending college, 66% of students surveyed will reside at home with family, 30% will live on campus, and 4% will live off campus not with family.
- 39% of students surveyed reported earning a scholarship. Surveyed students reported earning \$1,091,084 in scholarships to use at the schools they plan on attending.
- 68% of graduates filed the FAFSA or Alternative Application as reported by ISAC. 6% of seniors had not yet filed a FAFSA by graduation, but noted on the survey that they intend to do so.
- 49% of students who filed the FAFSA or Alternative Application qualify for the Federal PELL Grant as reported by ISAC.
- 43% of students who filed the FAFSA qualify for the Illinois MAP Grant as reported by ISAC.
- 31% of students who filed the FAFSA or Alternative Application had to complete Financial Aid Verification.

Of the 264 students who submitted applications:

40% submitted one

10% submitted two

6% submitted three

5% submitted four

7% submitted five

32% submitted six or more
