Teacher Student Success Act 2023 - 2024 Goals, Plan, Budget

At East Elementary School we are working to ensure high levels of achievement in all areas of a student's education.

One goal for the 2023-2024 school year at EES is to continue to use Mustang Meadows (our wellness room) to learn how to manage their own emotions and behavior as well as Cozy Corner areas in classrooms. This will give the students the opportunity to take a few minutes to disconnect from the stressful situation they are in, relax, recover and continue their learning in a better frame of mind. This is measured by the number of repeat students using the wellness room. We look for patters and address them with our school social worker, school counselor, wellness room aide and student success coach.

Our teachers strive to provide excellent instruction and interventions to our students. In order to do this our teachers need help with interventions. A portion of the budget will be set aside to pay for intervention aides to help students get extra help.

Title I interventions are an important part of helping fill the leaning gaps some of our students have. To help Title I run more effectively I will provide a \$2,000 stipend to the Title I supervisor, running Title I.

Students need unstructured time to more fully develop their creativity which helps their cognitive development which recess time provides. We will hire a recess aide to monitor students during their recess time.

Any carryover money will be used to fund our SEL programs, buy math manipulatives and/or increase intervention aide hours.

Our plan to reach these goals for our students include the following strategies:

- 1. Wellness room consumables/replacements as well as cozy corner consumables/replacements. We will start cozy corners in two new classrooms with each cozy corner having \$500 each set aside for materials/supplies \$2,100
- 2. Wellness room aide to supervise the room \$16,000
- 3. We would also like to provide additional money to extend instructional aide hours to provide more help to our struggling students. \$6,900
- 4. Recess Aide \$10,000
- 5. Title I Supervisor \$2,000

All monies for the 2022 - 2023 school year were spent as described.
