

**Denton Independent School District**  
**Rooftop Units Replacement for Ginnings Elementary Purchase**  
April 14, 2020

**SUMMARY:**

This item requests approval of the quote from TD Industries in the amount of \$660,075.00 for the replacement and installation of thirty-four (34) rooftop units at Ginnings Elementary.

**BOARD GOAL:**

Growth & Management – Demonstrate effective and efficient management of district resources

**PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:**

The Board called for the 2018 bond election with the recommendation by the Bond Committee. On May 5, 2018 the bond was approved by the voters of Denton ISD.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The replacement of thirty-four (34) rooftop units at Ginnings Elementary was included in the 2018 Bond Authorization. Thirty-four (34) rooftop units will be replaced with this purchase. The total cost of replacing all rooftop units for Ginnings Elementary is \$660,075.00.

**SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:**

The replacement and installation of the rooftop units will be purchased from TD Industries through a Texas Local Governmental Purchasing Cooperative OMNIA NIPA contract. This purchase is being brought for approval in accordance with the District’s CH (local) policy.

**FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:**

The cost will be borne through the 2018 Bond Authorization.

**BENEFIT OF ACTION:**

The approval of this purchase will allow the District to order and have the rooftop units installed in time to be ready for the 2020-2021 school year.

**SUPERINTENDENT’S RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the quote from TD Industries in the amount of \$660,075.00 for the replacement and installation of thirty-four (34) rooftop units at Ginnings Elementary be approved.
