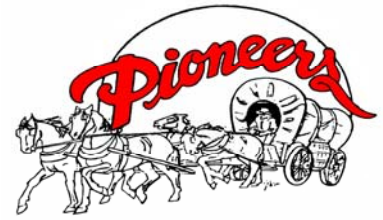

2013 Spring Afterschool Session

Dear Parents/Guardians of Students first through fifth grade,

Beginning **Monday, April 8th through Thursday, May 2nd**, Williams Elementary School will offer our Spring Afterschool Program. The spring session will be designed as an Academic and Activity time. The program will focus on building good homework habits and teaching students strategies to help them complete and turn in assignments. Students will be provided with a nutritional snack immediately following school, a quiet learning environment, individual tutoring, and staff that will help them complete homework assignments.
