

FPC Rahl Campus Board Report February 2026

- ESL and GED Spring I classes are going well. We have forty-four students enrolled in ESL and fourteen students enrolled in GED. We have beginning, intermediate, and advanced ESL classes.
- The ESL class for CDL students will begin on February 9th.
- Christy met with Franky Scott to discuss CDL Truck/Trailer needs. Submitted the report to Don Smith per his request.
- Spring enrollment was up overall. The traditional student enrollment dropped some due to several of our students completing in December and others who were enrolled in the fall semester transferring out to a university. Dual Credit enrollment was up significantly.
- The first group of Dual Credit Diesel Technology students started classes this spring. We have sixty-four enrolled.
- Christy met with the counselors from the four schools the Rahl Campus serves to confirm dual credit student's enrollment, planning for the next school year, and making sure the semester was going well.
- Christy met with the counselor at Dalhart High School to schedule dates to administer the ELAR and Math TSI.
- Christy will attend a virtual meeting with Windham School District.
- The last week of February, FPC staff will have a full workday in Dalhart to prepare fall classes at the Dalhart TDCJ Unit. The Regional Director assigned to Frank Phillips College will be in attendance to assist in our planning day.
- Yellow House will be touring the Rahl Campus Diesel Technology facility and meeting with students regarding an internship and other opportunities with the company.
- The new EDC Director in Dalhart is a dedicated supporter of FPC. He created vocational training advertising materials for the new electronic billboards which are located around Dalhart.
- Over the past month numerous CE and TCOLE classes were held on campus for Dalhart PD, Sherman County Sheriff's Office, DHCHD, and Hilmar.
