

## PROPOSED REVISIONS

### Extracurricular Activity Absences

The District shall make no distinction between absences for UIL activities and absences for other extracurricular activities approved by the Board.

In accordance with administrative regulations, a student shall be allowed in a school year a maximum of 26 extracurricular activity or public performance absences, with a limit of 18 absences in a semester, not related to post-district competition; however, the District shall not limit the number of absences for post-district, state, or other competition.

[For eligibility of a private school student, including a homeschool student, to participate in extracurricular activities, see FD(LOCAL).]

~~The District shall not schedule, nor permit students to participate in, an extracurricular activity or a public performance that would require, permit, or allow a student to be absent from class in any course more than 26 times in a school year and not to exceed 18 times in a semester.~~

### Additional Qualified Events

~~A student who has qualified or advanced beyond an initial level of competition prior to exceeding the days allowed above shall be granted additional days in that qualified activity to its completion.~~

### Alternative Education

~~Students enrolled in a GED program may participate in curricular and cocurricular activities but shall not be eligible for participation in extracurricular activities.~~

### Use of District Facilities

School-sponsored student groups may use District facilities with prior approval of the appropriate administrator. Other student groups may use District facilities in accordance with policy FNAB.
