There was lots of enthusiasm and participation that helped keep everyone cheery as we approached the end of the first semester.
- Other fun holiday activities this month included the Winter Music Concert on December 5th in the CHS gym and the CSD Christmas Party on Dec. 9th at the Pioneer. The Christmas Party was a fun time for teachers and staff to get together, share a potluck meal, exchange gifts, and socialize outside of school.

 conference and a post-observation conference). This process will be repeated in its entirety for
