THIS CONTRACT is entered into between the UNITED INDEPENDENT SCHOOL (herein referred to as "District"), acting through its Board of Trustees, and the law firm of VALLS & MARROQUIN, LLP (hereinafter referred to as "LAW FIRM"), a registered limited liability partnership of which each attorney is duly licensed to practice law in the State of Texas.

T.

The DISTRICT retains the LAW FIRM to provide legal services and representation to the DISTRICT limited to and in connection with all general legal matters and real estate matters. The DISTRICT agrees to pay the LAW FIRM a fee of \$280.00 per hour for attorneys with 20 years or more experience; \$250.00 per hour for attorneys with 5 to 10 years experience; and \$190.00 per hour for attorneys up to 5 years experience in consideration for such legal services. These fees are valid for one year and are subject to review and change at annual intervals.

II.

The LAW FIRM'S employment by the DISTRICT is strictly on an at-will basis and both parties may elect to terminate this contractual relationship at any time.

III.

The DISTRICT agrees to reimburse LAW FIRM for the following out-of-pocket expenses:

- a. Copying;
- b. Postage and overnight mail; and
- c. Other unusual expenses presently unforeseen but authorized in advance by the District.

III.

The State Bar of Texas investigates and prosecutes professional misconduct committed by Texas attorneys. Although not every complaint against or dispute with a lawyer involves
