State Track and Field

Students from Guyer and Ryan High represented Denton ISD in 10 events at the recent Class 5A and 4A UIL Track and Field State Championships at UT-Austin.

Guyer High won the Girls and Boys District 5-4A Track and Field titles. Guyer Girls also won the Region I track title in Abilene. Ryan High won the Boys District 4-5A title, Area 3-5A title, and finished in the Top Five overall at its regional meet in Lubbock.

Denton ISD qualified 43 student-athletes in 37 events at the 5A and 4A regional track meets – the largest contingent of athletes Denton ISD has sent to the regional meets the past five years.
