**LETTER OF AGREEMENT** September 1, 2018 – August 31, 2019

This letter of agreement is entered into between Family Service Association of San Antonio, Inc. (Family Service) and <u>Eagle Pass ISD</u> for the purpose of supporting the planning and implementation of the Middle Way Curriculum at the <u>Eagle Pass ISD Parent and Community Education Center</u>. The Middle Way Parenting Program is a communication-based, interactive program that supports the development of healthy family relationships and teaches compassionate assertiveness, empathetic/active listening, empowerment and other skills to strengthen family relationships. By fostering these skills, the Middle Way Parenting Program works to prevent future abuse within the home. For 8 weeks, 1 1/2 hours per week, participants engage in an introspective process of positive personal change.Through a collaborative agreement, Family Service will provide expertise and management of the program, recruitment and implementations of the Middle Way Curriculumfrom September 1, 2018 through August 31, 2019.

Family Service: will be responsible to provide the following tasks:

- 1. Provide administrative oversight, overall coordination and implementation of the parent group trainings.
- 2. Provide appropriate and required documentation of program activities and number of parents served: informational flyers, sign-in sheets, agendas, hand outs and program surveys
- 3. Provide assistance in tracking and reviewing outcomes for the purpose of future program development and growth
- 4. Provide certificates of completion/participation to all participants.
- 5. Provide programmatic items needed for implementation of trainings

Eagle Pass ISD: agrees to support and assist in the following tasks:

- 1. Provide appropriate space, custodial support and equipment for the implementation of the trainings at the center, during center's business hours.
- 2. Assist in identifying individuals interested in participating in services.
- 3. Provide administrative support of the program within the school and community
- 4. Track and review outcomes for future development and growth opportunities

## Other Conditions:

1. This agreement is contingent upon availability of funds. If Family Service does not receive funding to manage parenting programming, this agreement is not binding.
