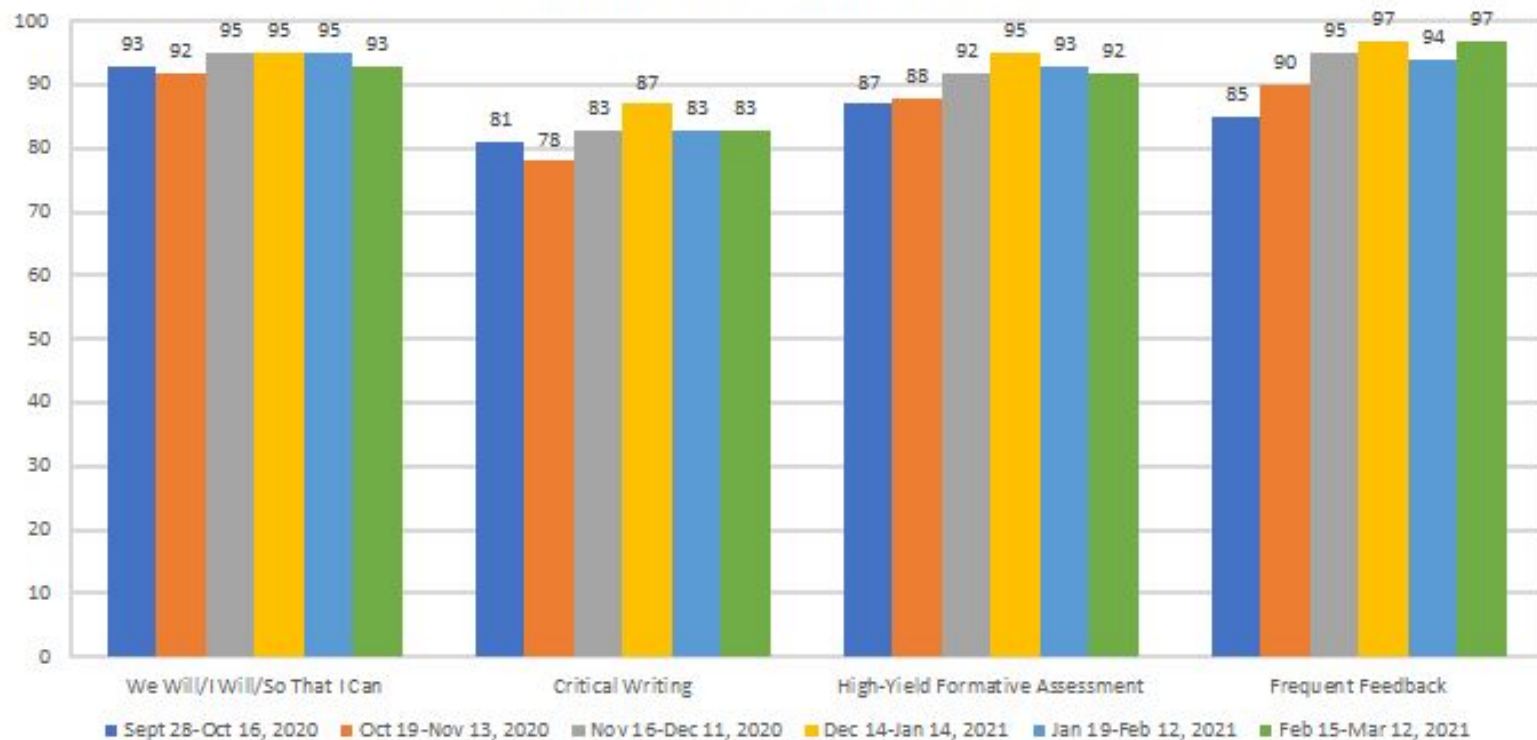

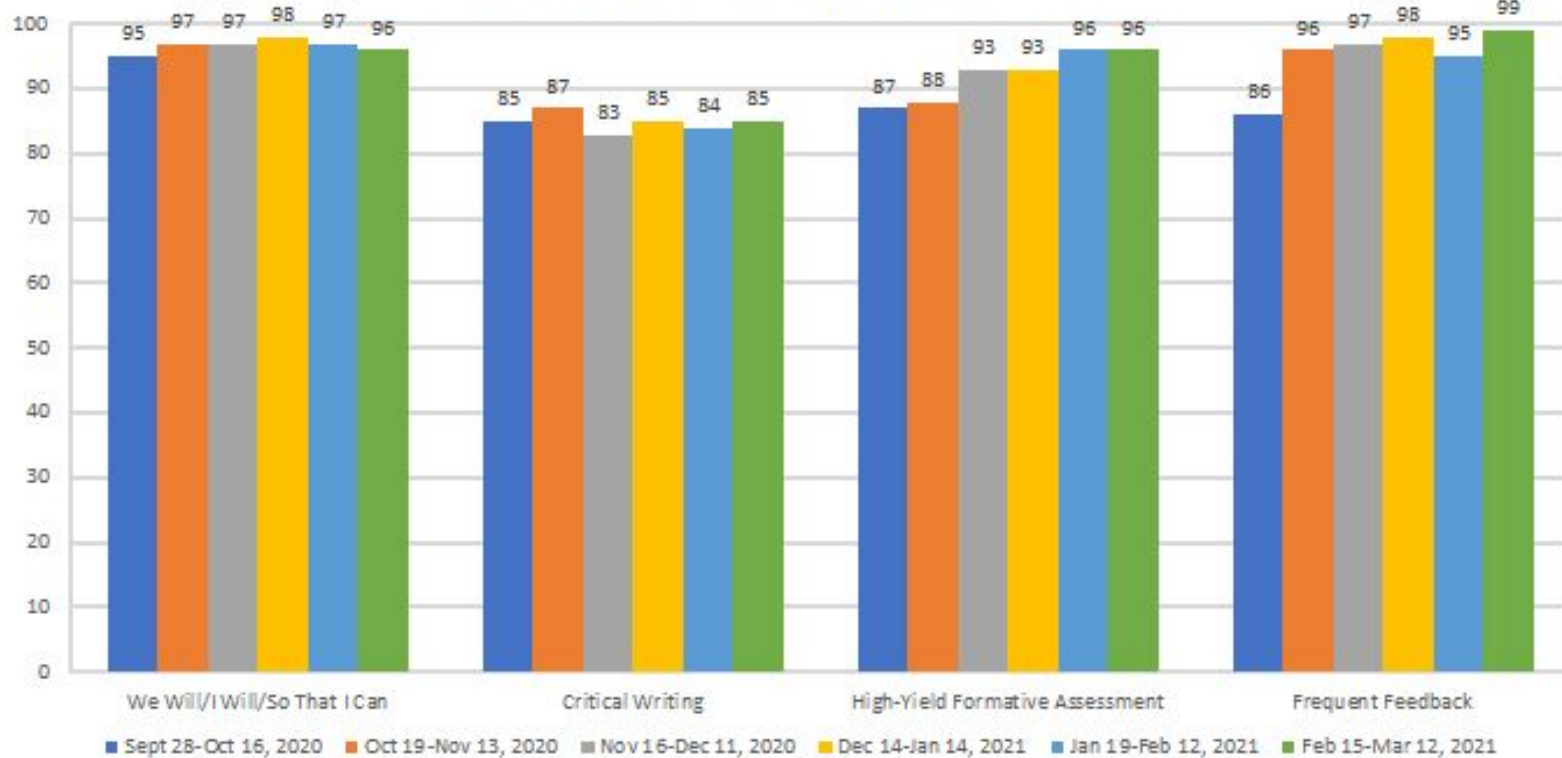

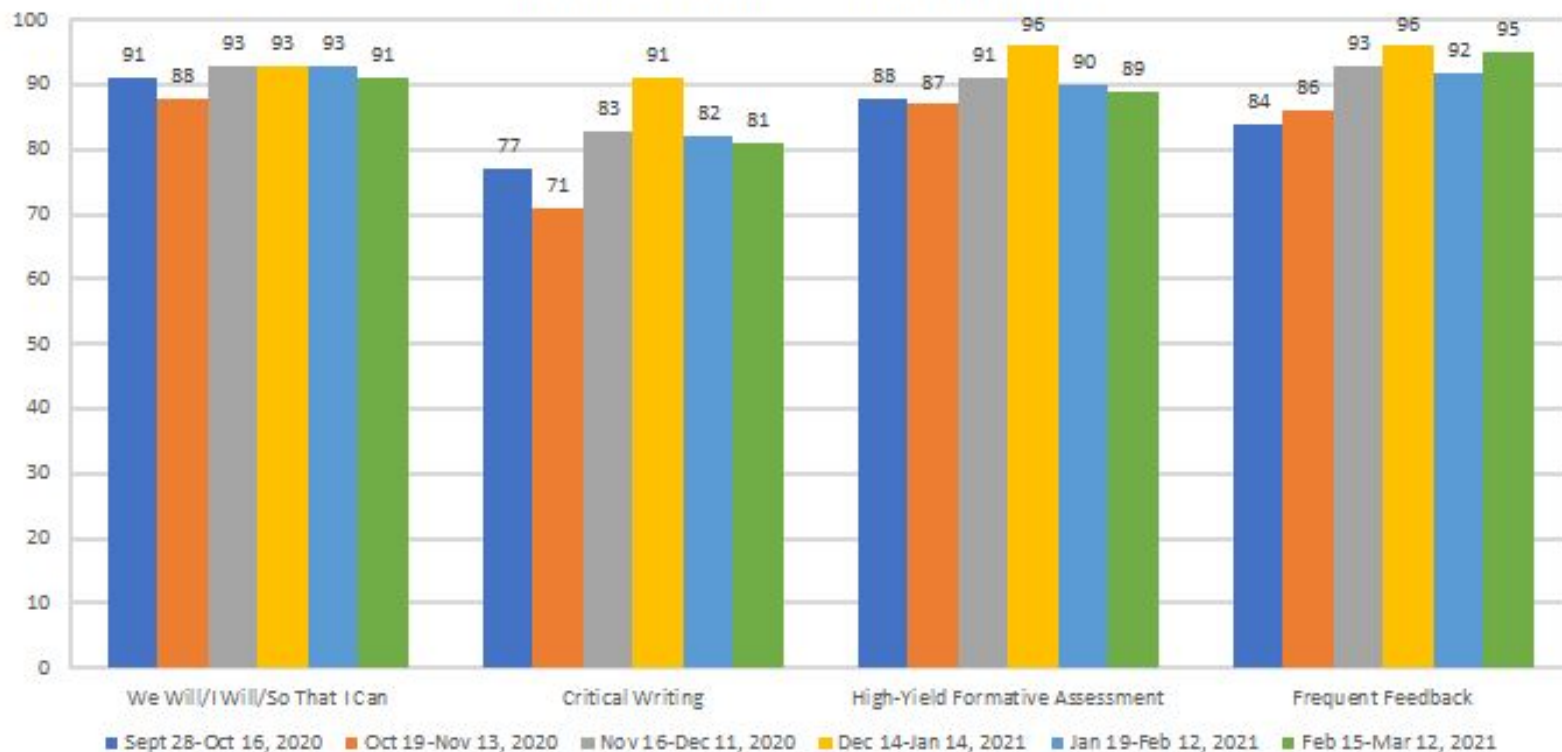
Aledo ISD Overall Growth by Look Fors

Compare the Average Score In 2019 to Other States/ Jurisdictions

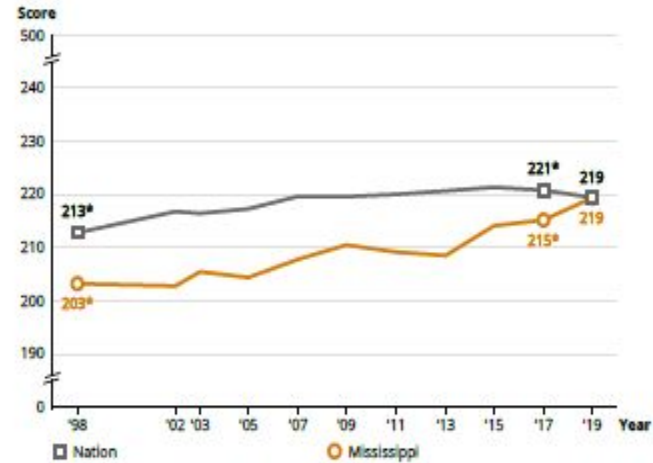


In 2019, the average score in Mississippi (219) was

- higher than those in 7 states/jurisdictions
- not significantly different from those in 33 states/jurisdictions

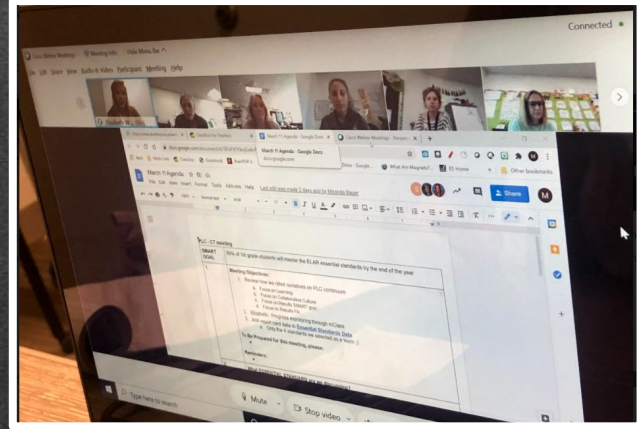

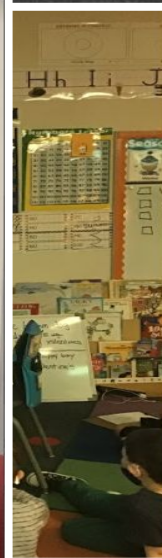
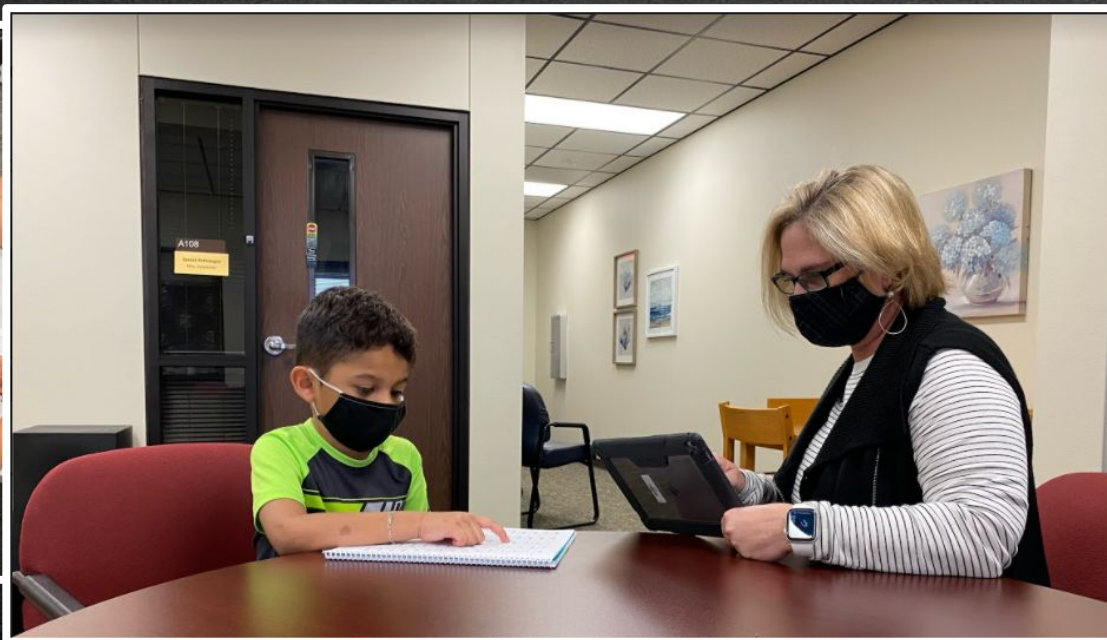

A Peek into our Future 2021-2022

HB3 Bill

- Per House Bill 3 (HB 3), passed by the 86th Texas Legislature in June of 2019, all kindergarten through third grade teachers and principals must attend a "teacher literacy achievement academy" by the 2022 - 2023 school year. For simplification and to avoid confusion with other grant programs and past literacy achievement academies, the Texas Education Agency is referring to this latest requirement as the HB 3 Reading Academies.

Texas Reading Academies

- **Goal:**
 - To increase teacher knowledge & implementation of evidence-based practices to positively impact student literacy achievement.
- **Steeped in the Science of Teaching Reading (STR)**
 - STR: Evidence-based reading methods that best support development of skilled reading.
 - 60 hours of professional learning / artifact submissions

Our Response to HB3:

- **2021-2022 Implementation of Reading Academies**
 - Grade Levels K, 1, and 2
 - Elementary Principals
 - Dyslexia / SPED
- **2022-2023 Implementation of Reading Academies**
 - Grade Level 3
 - Elementary Assistant Principals
 - New hires to K-3
