The 84th Legislature approved HB 2804, revising the Texas school accountability syste campus and district receives one of five ratings from A–F. Basics of HB 2804


- Creates five domains with three goals
 - Preparing students for postsecondary success
 - Reducing achievement gaps among students from different racial and ethnic groups and socioeconomic backgrounds
 - Informing parents and the community about district and campus performance
- Creates A-F rating labels to describe district & campus performance
- Established the fifteen-member Texas Commission on Next Generation Assessments & Accountability

for the overall grade




