3) Beginning of year DIBELS 2017-18 Composite Data

(Tawnya Campbell reviewed data with the team)

- a. kinder= 25% CORE; 27% Strategic, 48% Intensive
- b. 1st grade= 33% CORE, 16% Strategic, 51% Intensive
- c. 2nd grade= 41% CORE, 12% Strategic, 47% Intensive
- d. 3rd grade= 45% CORE, 19% Strategic, 35% Intensive
- e. 4th grade= 38% CORE, 11% Strategic, 51% Intensive

Team discussed data and compared it to the end of the year data from 2016-17 and looked at trends from previous years. The team was reminded of the RTIi process including the 20%/100% meetings that are already on the school's calendar. The first meetings will be with 3rd and 4th grade teams on September 25th and 1st, 2nd grade teams and kindergarten will meet on October 3rd. The teams will have 3 hours to review the beginning of the year data for the grade and then break done the 20% data and create reading intervention groups with Title, ERC, and the grade level teams based on the students' needs.

3) PBIS Update:

- a. PBIS kick-off assembly (September 29th)
 - All kids are invited to each assembly (this is a change from previous years), unless it is a consequence from teacher with principal approval
- B. Soar for Success (September 6th and 7th)
 - Purpose is to teach and model expectations of school rules by the aides that will be in charge during the day (empowering the staff)
 - ii. 5 station rotation (20 minutes at each station to teach, review, and model PBIS expectations in the hallways, cafeteria, on the bus (provided by 1st student), bathrooms, and recess areas.
 - iii. 1st and 2nd were able to participate on the 6th but 3rd and 4th had to be cancelled because of unsafe air quality (above 100); kindergarten will do it the following week with their classes and aides
