**Working together ~ we've got this! We will finish strong!**

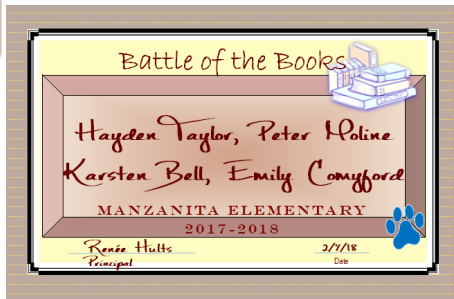

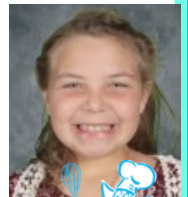

## F.Y.I

A staggering one of every five motor vehicle accidents take place in a parking lot

The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration estimates that 22 percent (more than one-fifth) of children between ages 5 and 9 killed in traffic crashes were pedestrians. Most of these accidents occurred because drivers failed to see kids while backing up their vehicles.

A Safe Kids Worldwide study showed that approximately 1 in 10 drivers were distracted by mobile devices while arriving or departing from school and nearly 1 in 3 displayed other unsafe behaviors, such as double parking or stopping in the middle of a crosswalk while dropping off students.

**Please remember to use caution at all times!!**

There are many field trips coming up during this last month and a half of school. It is our desire to provide interesting, informative, fun, and educational field trips. As we venture out, it is also our desire that our students & families conduct themselves in a manner that reflect well on the Three Rivers and Manzanita school community.
