ADV (Advanced Course/Dual Enrollment Completion) – 30% or more 9-12th graders completing and receiving credit for at least one ADV

APIB (Advanced Placement/International Baccalaureate Results) - 15% or more 11th/12th graders taking at least 1 AP or IB exam <u>AND</u> 50% scoring at or above the criterion on at least 1 exam

COLL READY (College Ready Graduate) - 40% or more graduates scored at or above the college ready criteria in both ELA and Math

- **RHSP** (Recommended High School Program/DAP) 85% or more of the graduates are meeting or exceeding the requirements for RHSP/Distinguished Achievement Program
- SAT/ACT (SAT/ACT Results) 70% of graduates take either SAT/ACT <u>AND</u> 40% or more score at or above the criteria score (SAT 1110, ACT Composite 24)
- **TSI (Subject)** (Higher Education Readiness Component: Math/ELA) 65% or more of 11th graders received a scale score of 2200 or more on the readiness component for math
- **COMM SSTD** (Commended Performance Social Studies) 30% or more of examinees scored at or above Commended Performance level
- COMM (Subject) Commended Performance Reading/ELA/Math/Writing/Social Studies/Science
 - 30% or more of examinees scoring at or above TAKS Commended Performance standard
- Cl (Subject) Comparable Improvement Math/Reading
 - Average vertical scale score growth in Math/Reading was in Top Quartile (25%)
- ATT Attendance
