Consent Agenda #11: MOU between SSAISD and EISD

Question: If the districts have different academic calendars and South San students assigned to the Edgewood DAEP will have to adhere to the EISD calendar, will that pose any problems for the students? **Answer:** South San students assigned to the DAEP in Edgewood will follow the South San Academic calendar. There is little difference between the two calendars.

Question: The MOU indicates we will provide transportation for our students. What are the pickup points for our students? **Answer:** Shepard cluster – corner of Five Palms and Medina Base Rd.; Dwight cluster – in front of former STEEP building across from Dwight parent center; Zamora cluster – corner of Gillette and Lytle

Question: The MOU indicates that we are paying expenses for a total of 20 students. If the Edgewood DAEP reaches capacity before our 20 students or if we have more than 20 students to assign to the DAEP but capacity has been reached what happens to those students? **Answer:** The MOU guarantees South San space for the assignment of 20 students. If South San exceeds the 20 slots, the MOU states that South San will pay a daily rate of \$56.82 for each additional student beyond 20 students.

Question: Who will administer the STAAR/EOC tests? **Answer:** South San at the student's home campus.

Question: Are we capable of sending the appropriate personnel to conduct ARD and 504 proceedings in a timely manner in order to comply with applicable law?
