SUBJECT: Bus Bid Results - 2013 Bond

During the October 24 BOE Study Session, Harry Lau and I brought forward information to the Board regarding going out to bid for the purchase of 24 new school buses from the 2013 bond. This proposed purchase and the effect on our bus fleet was then discussed at the Committee of the Whole meeting on November 7, 2016. I would now like to discuss the bid results with the Committee of the Whole on Monday, December 5, 2017.

This would be the final planned bus purchase out of the 2013 bond. Harry Lau, Administrator of Facilities and Operations, is recommending the purchase of thirteen (13) mini buses (A-2) from Midwest Transit Equipment, Marshall, Michigan for a cost of \$644,072.00. In addition, he is recommending the purchase of eight (8) 77-passenger long body conventional buses plus three (3) 72-passenger conventional special needs buses from Holland Bus Company, Holland, Michigan for a cost of \$985,059.00. The combined total of this proposed purchase of 24 buses is \$1,629,131.00.

Again, this is a planned purchase from the 2013 bond. I have attached a memo from Mr. Lau with additional details. Please feel free to contact me if you have any questions.
