2. Approve Draft Minutes: The August 11, 2025 minutes were approved.

3. Plante Moran Audit Report

Corey VanDyke and Charles Sportel of Plante Moran presented the results of the Financial Audit Report for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025. The results included the required Audit Communication and highlighted pertinent information in detail to the Committee.

The auditors issued an unmodified opinion on the financial statements, which indicated that the financial statements are accurate and in accordance with accounting guidelines.

Plante Moran will present the audit to the full Board on October 20, 2025.

4. Central Office Wage Recommendation

Deputy Superintendent Anderson presented the Central Office Wage Recommendation to the Committee. Jeff Rahmberg of Rahmberg Stover & Associates presented a recommendation to the Personnel Committee yesterday. A survey of the Universe Group was conducted to assess compensation for Central office staff. After review, the Committee agreed to the wage recommendation in the amount of \$36,091, to be applied retroactively to July 1, 2025.

5. Budget Report

Director McElroy presented the September 2025 Budget Report to the Committee for their review. The Committee discussed the state budget's bottom-line funding, which remains unclear. Initial reports suggested a \$442 per pupil increase, current projections indicate the increase is closer to \$150 per pupil.
