Report – April 2022

Classes

- We had our Tiger Cub Basketball Camp in January/February. We had 49 participants. Coach Kubat and Coach Boehning split the instruction along with some varsity basketball players. Kids love having the coaches and players do the coaching! It was a very successful camp.
- We are starting to put together summer camps/classes. This is in the early stages of getting started.

Driver Education

- We found another Driver Ed instructor! Miriam Rogers started helping with Session 2 of Classroom Training.
- Session 2 of the Classroom Training finished on Monday, March 11. We had 19 students take the class. We are offering Session 3 starting Monday, May 9. An email blast was sent out to parents the first week of April. We currently have 3 students signed up.
- Summer Behind the Wheel Training will have around 75 students that could take training this summer. Sign up is ongoing at this time. Mr. Larson and Ms. Rogers will split time. We hope to start this in mid/late May.
