Background Information:

- In May of 2015, a random sampling of Aledo ISD students in grades 6 – 12 participated in the *Texas School Survey of Drug and Alcohol Use*
- A summary of the report of the *Texas School Survey of Drug and Alcohol Use* as well as intended next steps and an overview of training elements were presented at the November 16, 2015 regular Board meeting
- Next steps for addressing the data found in the survey included the implementation of prevention programs to increase awareness amongst students regarding the dangers related to drug use and abuse
- On January 25, the School Health Advisory Council (SHAC) reviewed and unanimously recommended the utilization of a program called *Too Good For Drugs* to be available to AISD students in all grades, specifically targeted at 6th and 9th grades
