Background Information:

 In May of 2015, a random sampling of Aledo ISD students in grades 6 – 12 participated in the Texas School Survey of Drug and Alcohol Use

- A summary of the report of the Texas School Survey of Drug and Alcohol Use as well as intended next steps and an overview of training elements were presented at the November 16, 2015 regular Board meeting
- Next steps for addressing the data found in the survey included the implementation of prevention programs to increase awareness amongst students regarding the dangers related to drug use and abuse
- On January 25, the School Health Advisory Council (SHAC) reviewed and unanimously recommended the utilization of a program called *Too Good For Drugs* to be available to AISD students in all grades, specifically targeted at 6th and 9th grades
