

CROSBY-IRONTON SCHOOLS
BUILDINGS & GROUNDS COMMITTEE MEETING SUMMARY
June 15, 2020

Item 7.2b

The buildings and grounds committee met via teleconference on June 15, 2020 at 11:00 a.m. with the following: Jill Decent, Barb Neprud and Mike Domin. Jared Matson, Carmen Zahn, Jamie Skjeveland and Bill Tollefson were also present.

Galovich Gym Renovations –

Sound System Upgrade – The committee received a summary on the process that had been used to obtain two professional opinions and quotes relating to improvements to the sound system in the Galovich Gym. The first vendor reviewed the current system and provided a quote to completely replace all elements of the existing system, including new speakers at a cost of \$90,000. The second vendor proposed reusing many of the existing system's component parts, such as speakers, noting that much of the issue is probably in collecting the sound and modifying it before it is distributed by the speakers. The second vendor provided a price to upgrade the existing system at a cost of \$10,000. The committee was in agreement that it would be best to try to approach of the second vendor before proceeding with a complete system overhaul.

Scoreboards – The committee received a summary on the process that had been used to obtain two quotes for new scoreboard systems. Prices ranged from replacement of the existing scoreboard (now 15 years old) with a similar, traditional scoreboard at \$40,000 to \$50,000 to replacement with a digital scoreboard system at costs exceeding \$160,000. One vendor provided scoreboards through the Sourcewell quote using Daktronics and the other vendor contact was obtained from an A.D. contact at Detroit Lakes. The other vendor provided a variety of options for digital scoreboards. After review the A.D. recommendation was to provide matching digital scoreboards on both sides of the gym that are 8'2.4" by 14'9.17" and associated controller systems and software, along with the addition of LED shot clocks and backboard strip lights. This is at a cost of \$125,400. There will be additional costs to provide the necessary level of electricity to the scoreboard locations. The costs savings from the reduced price on the sound system project will allow additional resource to be spend on the scoreboards to help polish the apple in the Galovich Gym. Funding will come from Operating Capital and/or LTFM funds, depending on qualifying criteria, as new scoreboards were not included in the cost estimates used to arrive at a total amount to bond for in the school building bond referendum.

The meeting adjourned at 11:30 a.m.
