




### Listening Comprehension Results




### Reading Comprehension Results

### Conclusions



- ◆ Areas of strength: Listening and Reading
  - Continue to implement a variety of reading and writing activities across grade levels.
- Areas for improvement: Speaking and Writing
  - ◆ Increase number of Speaking activities in 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade to reinforce oral skills.
  - ◆ Develop more written activities in 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade to improve writing skills.
- ◆ The Spanish Exit Exam is...
  - a useful tool for informing our instruction
  - a valuable assessment that assists in the placement process at Amity Middle School



Future Plans

- Review all four sections of the test on an annual basis
- Plan to administer a revised writing assessment in 6<sup>th</sup> grade at the beginning and end of the year.
- Create a new writing assessment in 5<sup>th</sup> grade to gauge student progress in preparation for 6th grade.
- Continue to share test results with Amity Middle School on an annual basis in order to assist in placement process for 7th grade

- Continue to challenge advanced students!
