- Preparing for careers and work environments of the future (and present)
- Enhanced learning experiences
 / engagement (durable tasks)
- Personalized learning
- Opportunities for feedback



- Efficiency of operational tasks
- Research and innovation
- Accessibility improvements
- Critical thinking

- Ethical considerations
- Over-reliance on Al
- Plagiarism
- Inappropriate / Unacceptable use





Al falls under the broader umbrella of **digital literacy**.

Digital literacy entails:

- Digital safety
- Media and information literacy
- Digital well-being
- Social responsibility

This requires critical thinking skills, questioning, and a stance of inquiry.





<u>Essential Question:</u> How can AI be leveraged appropriately and ethically in NFPS as a tool for innovation, efficiency, and learning across stakeholders?

Objectives

- (1) To bring together stakeholders with multiple perspectives to develop guiding principles for AI that are situated in the broader context of digital literacy.
- (2) To research, examine, and shape guidelines / norms for the permissible and ethical use of AI in NFPS (including student-facing norms).
- (3) To explore, examine, and experience AI tools and resources in order to inform professional learning for all faculty and staff and learning experiences for students.
