Program 1: Extended School-Year Program

Focus

- Approx. 50 students with identified special needs, invited through PPT process

Curriculum

- Determined based on IEP needs

Timing

- July 5*-29, Monday-Thursday, between 8-10, or 9-12, depending on student needs

Staffing

- Approximately 11 special education teachers, 15 teachers' assistants, & 3 additional student support personnel

Funding Source

- FY 2022 operating budget, plus recent CSDE grant, to support teachers, TAs, & supplies

Program 2: Learning Recovery Program

Focus

- Approx. 110 students identified as having learning loss in literacy and/or mathematics, invited through data analysis process, or parent request if room available

Curriculum

- Determined based on key literacy & math standards

Timing

- July 5*-22, Monday-Thursday, between 10-12:30

Staffing

- Approximately 12 general education teachers, 6 teachers' assistants, & 4 specialists

Funding Sources

- ESSER II grant to support teachers & TAs; Operating budget to support supplies

Program 3: Summer Enrichment

Focus

- “So You’re Coming to Kindergarten”
- Other enrichment areas (e.g., STEM, visual arts) based on recent parent/guardian survey

Curriculum

- Currently TBD based on staff availability matching parent/guardian interest

Timing

- July 5*-22, Monday-Thursday, between 8-10

Staffing

- Currently TBD based on staff availability matching parent/guardian interest

Funding Sources

- Program revenues to support director, instructors, aides, & supplies

Curriculum Development

- Focus Area = Literacy (broadly conceived)
 - a. Reading / Writing / Social Studies
 - b. Attention to issues of inclusion & culturally responsive pedagogy
 - c. Attention to integration of technology to support instruction
- Focus Area = Grade 6 Pre-Algebra
 - a. Attention to appropriate standards-based scope & sequence
 - b. Attention to supporting student learners
