- 1. What is something that you would like very much to do for or with your students but you cannot currently afford to do it? Our students have restored a school greenhouse and planted a small garden; we are in need of gardening supplies that would allow students to learn about a variety of edible herbs and vegetable growing in Arizona.
- 2. In 200 words or less, describe this project, listing the estimated costs of the items of the planned project totaling up to \$600. Each student would be responsible for one urban planting container; it should include a perennial plant from last year, a new seedling, and an area to plant a new herb or vegetable from seeds. The students would observe their plants growth, take notes, learn botanical terms, the life cycle of a plant, best conditions of plant growth, practice plant maintenance, and use their observations to report in a variety of writing formats.

The items to purchase are as follows: seedlings (\$150); urban planting containers (\$100); pots (\$80); hose heads (\$34); gloves (\$50); soil (\$75); seeds (\$10).
