BUDGET COMMITTEE REPORT

South San Antonio ISD

The SSAISD Budget Committee held a meeting on Thursday, May 2, 2019 at 10:00 AM. The Board of Trustees received the materials presented at that meeting on Thursday, May 2, 2019 at 5:45 PM. Below are the highlights of the meeting.

- A report of the Budget Process and Timelines was presented by the Superintendent. I will
 recommend to the Budget Committee that a recommendation be forwarded to the Board of
 Trustees for their consideration that a detailed budget be presented to and adopted by the
 Board of Trustees.
- 4. A report of the SSAISD delinquent tax collections was presented by the Superintendent.
- 5. A report of the preliminary tax values was presented by the Superintendent.
- 6. A report of the Workers Compensation fund was presented by the Superintendent.
 - a. As of February 28, 2019 the balance in that fund is \$11.6 million.
 - b. Current fiscal year expenditures are \$432,347 with an actuarial analysis estimated unclaimed liabilities of approximately \$503,000.
 - c. The projected net funding for 2018-2019 is approximately \$629,000 which is estimated over an approximate 5-year trend.
 - d. SSAISD has not made a contribution to this fund in the past two fiscal years.
 - e. The Workers Compensation fund is as a "local restricted fund."
 - f. The balance in that fund should be maintained at a level consistent with SSAISD historical trends.
 - g. SSAISD currently self-funds Workers Compensation and a discussion on alternate means of funding will be discussed at the Budget Committee and Budget Workshop level.
- 7. A report and on the current school finance legislation was presented by Moak, Casey and Associates.
- 8. A preliminary 2019-2020 budget was presented by the Superintendent.
- 9. Architects Garza, Bomberger and Associates presented on the progress of opening schools.
- 10. A report on district priorities for maintenance, improvement, and construction activities was presented by the Superintendent.
- 11. A discussion on the re-opening of schools took place. The Superintendent indicated to the committee that the SSHS principal was amenable to modifying the schedule to accommodate the students at West Campus High School.
- 12. A report of all expenditures and encumbrances to date regarding the opening of Athens, Kazen, West Campus, and the Olivares complex was presented by the Superintendent.
- 13. A report on the progress and development of marketing initiatives was presented by the Superintendent.
- 14. A recommendation to the Board of Trustees by the Budget Committee to cease the feedback on reopening campuses surveys as been forwarded.
- 15. A recommendation to accept the Superintendent's recommendation to have informational community meetings regarding the re-opening of Athens, Kazen, and West Campus has been forwarded.
