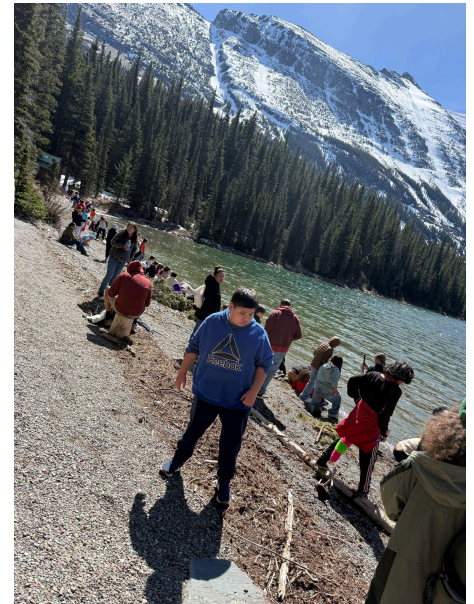
## May 2026 Board Report

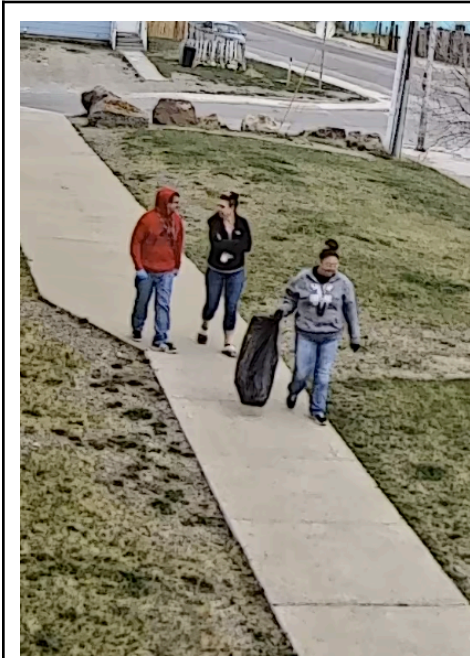
## **4th Grade Field Trip**

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### **Counseling Department**

The Napi Counseling Department utilizes a multi-tiered system of support (MTSS) to best utilize available resources. Tier 1: Universal Supports (100% of students receive); Tier 2: Targeted Supports (19% of students receive), and Tier 3: Intensive Supports (11% of students receive).

Tier I MTSS Services - All students at Napi receive Tier I social-emotional supports. These supports include: Second Step SEL curriculum in specials rotation, career counseling in specials rotation, academic counseling, individual crisis support, daily semi-structured lunch social/emotional support groups, and a clothing closet, hygiene supplies, weekend food as needed. All 4th and 5th-grade students received Second Step lessons on problem-solving strategies during the month of February.

Tier II MTSS Services - Some students at Napi receive Tier II Social Emotional Supports. These supports include: daily check and connect, ROX Girls Group, Tamarack Grief Resource Center grief group, Dessa SEL small group, McKinnie Vento Homeless Program, 504 medical plans, and family support meetings as needed. Additionally, either Mrs. Roberts or Mr. Andreas conducts home visits to address attendance concerns by working with families as noted above.

Tier III MTSS Services - A small number of students at Napi receive Tier III licensed social-emotional supports. These supports include: PHQ-A depression screening and referral, ASQ suicide screening and referral, Gina Dosch, School-Based Therapist for in-person psychotherapy, Blackfeet Tribal Behavioral Health for in-person/telehealth psychotherapy, Sukapi Lodge for in-person/telehealth psychotherapy, Indian Health Services for in-person/telehealth psychotherapy and inpatient/outpatient treatment as needed. Counseling department staff assist students with transportation to in-person appointments with community partners.
